SPECIAL SCHOOL BOND ELECTION Proposition 2 Secure Our Future
Shall the Board of Education of the Smithton R-VI School District, Missouri borrow money in the amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) for the purpose of providing funds to implement safety and security improvements District-wide; to renovate and relocate the existing Elementary school drop off area and playground; to renovate and relocate the preschool; to provide covered areas at the entrance of the elementary and secondary buildings; to convert existing lighting to LED; to resurface parking lots; to renovate ceilings, floors, and walls in classrooms; to replace heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units; to upgrade sidewalks; to install new turf and landscaping; to the extent funds are available, acquire equipment and complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue general obligation bonds for the payment thereof resulting in an estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy of \$0.4500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation?
If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to increase from \$0.0000 to \$0.4500 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

SPECIAL SCHOOL LEVY ELECTION**Proposition Teachers**

Shall the Board of Education of the Otterville R-VI School District, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy by \$0.3000 to \$3.9108 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the purposes of attracting and retaining quality certified staff?

If this proposition is approved the adjusted operating tax levy, of the District is estimated to increase by \$0.3000, from \$3.6108 currently to \$3.9108 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the 2025 Tax Year, and can be applied to the assessed valuation for each year thereafter. The District intends to reduce the debt service levy by \$0.3000 per one hundred dollars, of assessed valuation to offset the estimated \$0.3000 increase to the operating levy if this proposition is approved by the voters, resulting in the total tax levy of the District remaining unchanged.
