

The Morgan County Commission met Tuesday April 8, 2025, at 8:30 am in the Morgan County Commissioner's meeting room.

The following were present: Presiding Commissioner-Tony Stephens, Eastern District Commissioner-Brian Lehman, Western District Commissioner-Trent Edgar, Administrative Assistant-Mallory Wilhelm, Deputy Clerk-Amanda Haggerman, County Clerk-Aimee Worthley, Treasurer-Rhonda Campbell, Morgan County resident-Lavern Zimmerman, and Ryan Miller with Capital Materials.

Commissioner Lehman made the motion to approve the meeting minutes from the March 26<sup>th</sup> meeting. Commissioner Edgar seconded. The vote was as follows: 3 yes/0 no. Motion carried.

Presiding Commissioner Stephens opened the gravel and rock bids that were submitted. Only one gravel bid was submitted. The single gravel bid was from Fischer Materials. There were four white rock bids submitted. Capital Materials (Laurie & Bagnell), Fisher Materials, Higgins, and Siegel Quarry were the companies that submitted bids to the County. Commissioner Lehman made the motion to accept all the gravel and rock bids that were submitted. Commissioner Edgar seconded. The vote was as follows: 3 yes/0 no. Motion carried.

Commissioner Lehman made a motion to approve the Supplements/Additions/Deletions from the County Collectors' office for the month of March. Commissioner Edgar seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: 3 yes/0 no. Motion carried.

Commissioner Edgar made a motion to approve Morgan County Resolution 040825 (Sunshine Law Policy). Commissioner Lehman seconded. The vote was as follows: 3 yes/0 no. Motion carried.

Lavern Zimmerman had some questions about the road and bridge sales tax, budgeting, and school taxes. The Commission gave him copies of the gravel bids and went over the revenues and expenditures for the road and bridge budget. Discussion was had on possible solutions to help build the roads up, bridge repair, and concrete work. No action was taken.

Commissioner Lehman made a motion to approve the bills presented. Commissioner Edgar seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: 3 yes/0 no. Motion carried.



The next Commissioner's meeting will be April 16<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 A.M.


